About Our Guest Conductor

Paul Morton grew up in southwestern Pennsylvania and started playing the clarinet in the third grade. He continued to play the clarinet through middle school but switched to the tuba when he went to High School. The tuba soon became his instrument of choice. Paul Morton had great musical success in high school, so he auditioned for West Virginia University, where he received a scholarship to study music education.

Mr. Morton attended and graduated from West Virginia University in 1985 with a degree in music education. In the fall of 1985, he became band director of McArthur High School in Hollywood, Florida, and stayed in that position for six years. In 1991 Paul took the position of band director at Driftwood Middle School (also in Hollywood Florida) and is still in that position today. He is in his 37th year of teaching and has an average of 340 students per day in Driftwood's band program.

Over the years, Paul Morton's bands have received top honors at band festivals with consistent superior ratings at Music Performance Assessments. Due to the success of Paul's bands, he was elected to become a music adjudicator for the Florida Band Master's Association. He is often hired to travel around the state of Florida to evaluate concert bands, and individual events (Solo and Ensembles).

Paul is an active member of the Florida Band Master's Association, Florida Music Educators Association, National Association for Music Education, American School Band Director's Association, Broward Music Educators Association, and Phi Beta Mu.

Along with his responsibilities at school, Paul is also the Music Director at Plantation Community Church. Paul is married to Zuli Morton and has four children and two grandchildren.

About Our Guest Conductors

High School Honors Band Conductor - Kimberly Beene

Kimberly Beene began her teaching career in 2007 and is currently the head band director at Arbor Creek Middle School in Carrollton, TX. Ensembles under her direction have consistently received first division ratings at contests across the state. Her responsibilities at ACMS include directing the Honors Band, Jazz Band, assisting with the Symphonic Band, and teaching all beginner woodwind classes. In 2022, the Arbor Creek Honors Band was named a National Winner in the Mark of Excellence band competition and placed 4th at the TMEA CC State Honor Band Contest.

Mrs. Beene graduated Summa Cum Laude and received her Bachelor of Music Education degree from Texas State University. Her primary instrument is the flute. During her time at Texas State, Mrs. Beene was a drum major for the Bobcat Marching Band, member of the Wind Ensemble, Symphony Orchestra, and was awarded the Outstanding Senior in Instrumental Education by the music education faculty.

Mrs. Beene is an active member of the professional music education community. She has presented clinics at various professional conferences, including the Texas Music Education Association and the Texas Bandmasters Association conventions, and at the Young Educators Seminar at SMU. She has also served as the TMEA Region 31 Middle School Band Coordinator.

Mrs. Beene resides in Carrollton with her husband Phil (a percussion instructor in Frisco ISD) and their cats Widget & Torchy.

High School Symphonic Band Conductor - Jeffrey L. Miller

Jeffrey L. Miller is Director of Bands at Tennessee Technological University. In this capacity, Dr. Miller serves as conductor of the Symphony Band and Concert Band, is Director of the Golden Eagle Marching Band, teaches courses in Instrumental Conducting & Literature, and other courses in the music education curriculum.

Prior to his appointment at Tennessee Technological University, he served as Associate Director of Bands/Director of Athletic Bands at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, and as Assistant Director of Bands at the University of Colorado-Boulder. Miller holds a Bachelor of Music Education degree from Florida Southern College, a Master of Music Education and Ph.D. in Music Education, with emphasis in instrumental conducting, from Florida State University. Prior to his university appointments, Miller served as a band director in the state of Florida where he directed middle and high school bands.

Dr. Miller's research interests include evaluating quality in wind band literature for school ensembles. His article, *An Analysis of James M. Stephenson's Symphony No. 2—Voices: With Commentary by the Composer*, was recently published in the prestigious Journal of Band Research. He has presented research and teaching clinics at national, regional, and state-level conferences, including the CBDNA Athletic Band Symposium, the CBDNA/NBA Southern Division Conference, and the Colorado, Florida, Indiana, North Carolina, Tennessee, and Virginia Music Educator's Conferences. He has conducted honor bands throughout the South-eastern United States and enjoys an active schedule as an adjudicator/clinician for concert and marching assessments.

Dr. Miller holds professional memberships in the National Association for Music Education, the College Band Directors National Association, Pi Kappa Lambda Music Honor Society, Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, and is an honorary member of Kappa Kappa Psi National Band Fraternity.
